Re: Bus Passes

Transportation is provided for students of the Selah School District who need a ride on a **daily** basis to/from school. Because we count daily for the State Ridership program, we generate funding for students who are on the bus. It is the goal of the state as well as the district to make sure that we have buses that are full **daily** to capacity in order to match our funding so that we can provide the service without running the program in the Red. In order to run our program efficiently, we cannot save spots for students who may need a ride on occasional days here and there, or a couple times a year. Because of this, we cannot accept bus passes for students to have friends ride home with them on the following routes as they are currently transporting between 70-78 students: #1, #3, #4, #6, #7, #8, #10, #13, and #14. If you are planning to have a party or after school functions, please be prepared to provide transportation for your functions. Thank you for your understanding.
