A Look at Selah School District
Inclement Weather Operating Decisions
for Hybrid Instruction During the 2020-2021 School Year












As we prepare for Ole' Man Winter there are often operating decisions that must be made in local school districts. In Selah, student and staff safety is the priority. Many factors are considered in the operating process, where morning decisions are primarily based on Selah's specific weather, road conditions and forecast. This winter as school operating decisions are made, **three options will be considered:**

- Use of Alternate Bus Routes
- Delay of In-Person Instruction for Inclement Weather; AM Remote
Students who attend a **morning session** for in-person learning or for a small group will **transition to remote instruction for the day**. Afternoon students will participate in on-campus instruction as scheduled.
- Cancellation of In-Person Instruction; Transition to Remote
Both **AM and PM students** who attend in-person learning or a small group will **transition to remote learning from home**.

In the event of winter school delays or cancellations, the transition to remote learning will reduce the need for a "snow make-up" day later in the year.
